Re: Construction update – Spit Bridge drive system upgrade
Notice of extended working hours from Monday 27 February, 2012

As you may be aware, preliminary work to enable the upgrade of the Spit Bridge drive system commenced in January 2012. Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) has contracted Lend Lease to carry out this work.

This \$10.6 million project is fully funded by the NSW Government and is being undertaken to enhance the longevity and reliability of the bridge drive system, minimising the potential for traffic delays caused by a breakdown of the lift equipment.

The next stage of work involves installing scaffolding, submarine cables and mechanical equipment.

Standard day time working hours are **Monday to Friday** from **7am to 6pm** and **Saturdays** from **8am to 1pm**. Because Spit Bridge opens to a schedule, work during the day is intermittently disrupted. To minimise the overall duration of this project, RMS has approved an extension to weekday working hours.

From Monday 27 February, 2012 extended working hours will be Monday to Friday from 7am to 8pm. Weekend working hours will remain unchanged.

There will be noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of noise on local residents and business operators.

Up to date information regarding this work, including any date changes, road closures or detours, will be displayed on electronic message signs along the roadway, on bridge banners and on our website www.rms.nsw.gov.au/roadprojects.
