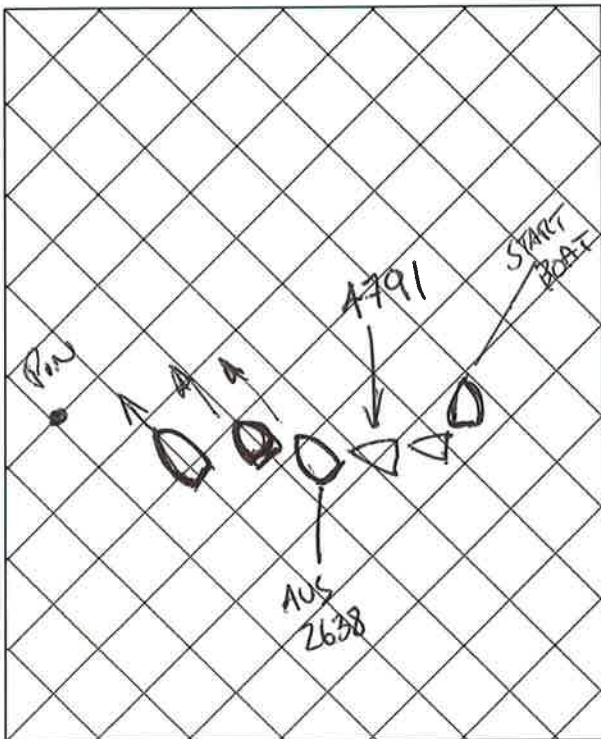

WHEN SAILING AT THE START AND FULLY ON THE WIND, WE HAD SEVERAL BOATS TO LEeward. AUS 791 WAS RUNNING THE LINE BECAUSE THEY WERE EARLY. I HAILED TWICE TO COME UP WITH NO RESPONSE FROM THE YACHT AT ALL TO CHANGE COURSE WE GOT HIT IN THE STB SIDE AFT MAKING US TACK OVER WHILE STILL ATTACHED. WE BROKE TWO STANCHIONS, THREE HOLES & A BROKEN SPINN POLE.
